Nursery (Pam Fisher): Children one year old and under are welcome in the nursery.

REGISTER EARLY! We are over 500 registrants already! There are 2 options for registration! You can register online at www.rpic2020.org or download a registration form from the conference website and mail it. We prefer online registration. You can register and pay online—or register online and mail your payment to avoid the 3% convenience fee for using your credit card. For those using a paper registration form, please include the grades of your children from K-12th grade. To answer your questions, there is a Q&A page on the website. **Registration closes May 30, 2020.**

Lodging Info: Options for lodging include: 1) Standard Dorm Suites (2 bedrooms [2 beds each] sharing a bathroom); 2) 2- and 3-Bedroom Lodge Suites (each bedroom containing 2 beds), living room, and unfurnished kitchenette (available first to large immediate families, then first-come, first-served); 3) 4-Bedroom Dorm Suites, which contain 4 bedrooms with 2 beds each, living room, and 1 large bathroom (also available first to large immediate families, then first-come, first-served).

Our family lodging rates include a family discount designed to encourage families with children to attend. This savings applies to members of an immediate family with the same permanent address. You may have someone not in your immediate family stay with you, but they must pay the single person rate.

Lodging for married couples: The lowest-cost lodging option for a married couple with no children is to request 2 “single person, shared occupancy.” The lodging cost for 2 would be \$270. If you prefer a private dorm suite (not sharing the bath with another couple), request 2 “single person, single occupancy.” Lodging cost for 2 would be \$400. These costs do not include the meals and program fee.

Deposit/Payments: A non-refundable \$50 deposit must be paid at the time of your online registration or within 10 days of registration if you mail your check to Kim Backensto, 3303 7th Ave., Beaver Falls, PA 15010. There is a 3% convenience fee to use a credit or debit card to pay your registration. This fee is NOT included in the advertised rates for the conference, but is added when you use your credit card for payment. Full payment must be received by July 1, 2020. Airport Transportation: Bus transportation will be available to and from the Indianapolis International Airport. On Tue., July 28, one bus will leave the airport for IWU at 2 PM and one bus at 6 PM. On Mon., Aug 3, one bus will leave IWU at 9 AM for the airport. Fees are \$20 one way/\$40 roundtrip (children under 12 free).

Note: Email the registrars to make a reservation for the bus.
